WREN AND CUFF

SUPER RUSSIAN

Thank you for picking up your new Wren and Cuff Super Russian. This is a wonderful addition to any musicians arsenal of pedals, or for the minimal effects user who runs this as their only distortion. You can cover a lot of ground with this little green monster.

What is it?

Muff side:

Take one of our renowned Tall Font Russian, 90's muff recreations.

Add a bit more heat/output

Add a toggle with the option to remove the traditional muff mid-scoop eq, and flatten out the mid response

And finally, add the fabled "Creamy Dreamer" mod to send things into a rich hyper-drive on command

Buffer-boost side:

On the PUSH side, we have a separate crystal clear transparent germanium buffered boost section before the muff to push things even harder if needed. This buffered boost can also be used on its own as a beautiful booster to beef up your clean tone and add a resplendent sheen that's hard to not fall in love with, or use it to push another pedal later down the chain.

Oh no, I think the "PUSH" side of my pedal is broken, it doesn't start boosting until the 12 o'clock position!

Your pedal isn't broken. The pedal is made to be this way so the the PUSH side can also be used as a second gain control. You have the option of pushing the front gain up, or pulling it down below unity (bypassed level). There are many cool sounds to be had this way. It lets you mimic the effect of a volume rollback on the guitar or bass, which will give the pedal a whole different feel. You've now essentially got two independent gain controls (the PUSH, and the DISTORTION control).

Experiment!

Internal order:

Guitar-> Clean Boost-> Tall Font Muff-> Amp
